- Boofest was a success
- · The PTA has two upcoming events:

### **Miscellaneous Business Report:**

Aleece de Vengoechea reported on the Fall Fundraiser

- \$125,713 raised for a net of \$91,713.10
  - New online/application bidding seemed to be a success
  - More money was raised in the Silent Auction this year compared to 2017
- 223 tickets (192 pre-sold) in 2018 vs. 211 in 2017
- · Unsold auction items are online for purchase/bid until this Wednesday

#### Joanna Hutchinson reported on the Pledge Drive

- \$3,500 was raised since the October MESF meeting
- \$53,500 raised to date- The hope is for the fundraising goal to be met before Artwalk
- Marketing was stopped for the Fall Fundraiser, but will start back up in January
- Dacy Yee suggested a push before the end of the year for those that want tax deductions for the 2018 year
- New marketing will consist of live student interviews with those staff that are funded by the MESF

## Jennifer Messenger reported on the School Directory

- · Getting 3rd bid on printing
- · Currently working on edits/formatting and the goal is disburse directory before Thanksgiving
- Sold 24 business ads and 11 personal ads-\$11,350 raised

#### Andi Bokosky reported on Spirit Wear

- · All orders have been completed
- May sell some sweatshirts and beanies in December

- Joanna Hutchinson volunteered to get get a bid on 3 more Pledge Drive Bucket Banners as well as banners that can be displayed next to these with a list of what the donations fund. Ideally, we could display these at the front of the school as well as at the Pembroke Gate.
- MESF awareness discussion regarding fathers of students. Sean and Jason volunteered to explore fundraising options that would appeal to them.
