- 2018/19 MESF Budget vs. Actual discussed
- · The office copy machine is a new expense this year
- Heidi discussed the success of Ralph's fundraising payback, actual is over what we had budgeted for this year. Update on Amazon Smile- and we have earned \$1900 since the inception of the program
- · Currently have \$292k in foundation accounts

- · Recently wrote \$55k check for the 3rd of 4 installments for the Teacher Aids
- · MESF has \$237k net once check is cashed

Principal's Report: Matt Broesamle

- · Coming to the end of our 2nd trimester
- In classroom 2nd Step Curriculum based on character education has been a success

Teacher's Report: Cara Boyd and Ellen Smith

- Mrs. Smith questioned status of the teacher's grant program. Sean reported that one request for \$500
 has been submitted. Currently have \$5k in the budget to disperse in \$500 increments.
- Jen M informed the teachers that the board is currently working on a form that will be available to teachers in order to submit grant requests
- Mrs. Boyd informed the board that the teachers would like to thank the foundation and help to increase
 the parent's awareness of what is funded by both the MESF and PTA. She is currently working on a
 template letter to be sent out to parents in hopes of doing this.

- · American Heart Association partnership- "Jumprope for heart" taking place next Friday

Miscellaneous Business Report:

Heather Scheck and Noelle Perrin reported on the Artwalk

- · May 18th at the Elks lodge
- · Art viewing will take place in the PFT on May 17th
- · Eternal/Forever Summer type theme

Alice Rochverger reported on the 4th of July event

- · This will be the 47th year it will take place in our community
- Alice has helped with the event for the last 6 years and is looking for someone to take over after this
 year. The majority of work goes into finding sponsorships within the local community. The event brings
 in about \$10k.

Sean Casey and Jason Perrin reported on the recent PFT update

- · In 2016, about \$25k was raised as a fund in need
- In the 2016/2017 school year, a deposit of \$12k was made by MESF toward improvements/update
- New speakers, a new sound system, and wall coverings were recently installed
- The MESF currently owes \$8700 for the improvements (Total invoice of \$21k minus the initial deposit). Mark Ontiveras was instrumental in the update and generously discounted where he could.
- · Currently getting quote for wireless microphones
- Heidi Perreault made a motion to authorize payment of \$8700 for the remainder of bill
 - · Melissa Meehan 2nd the motion
 - · Motion was approved

Erica Williams reported on the Pledge Drive

- To date \$60,333 has been pledged by 112 families, \$53k collected
- 2017/2018 School year Pledge Drive
 - At this time last year, \$10k more was pledged by a total of 112 families
 - · At the end of the summer, \$84,290 had been collected
- · 2018/2019 goal is to reach same amount or more
- · Flyers recently delivered to students to promote Pledge Drive
