## **MINUTES**

#### President's Report: Sean Casey

- MESF year in review- resigning member feedback, environment and culture
- Announcement of Sean C's resignation from MESF
- New changes coming for 2019-2020
- Reported on Pledge Drive- While numbers are down from last year, it appears we have lost some large donor families through Mariners attrition. All in all, a successful year!
  - Erica W. reported further details- \$64,600 YTD, Recurring payments successful as no one is delinquent, in the month of April +\$1,475
  - Joanna announced that Erica and Joanna will continue to chair pledge drive next year. New theme. "They succeed, We support!"

- · Reported on Ralph's Program- already raised \$5000 more than forecasted
- Reported on Artwalk- Event to take place on May 18th. Heather S briefly discussed details of event.
- Discussion regarding general board member voting:
  - Bylaws state at least 8 and no more than 25 MESF Board Members
  - Heidi P made a motion to change board member numbers from 23 to 25 members for 2019-2020 school year. Noelle P 2nd the motion.

Motion Approved to change Board Member Count to 23:

Yes: 10 No: 2

- Voting will be done online via a secret ballot. Jen M will email ballot which must be completed by Thursday, May 9th at 5pm.
- There are 4 open spots. You can vote for up to 4 new members. Ballots and votes will be counted by the Secretary and the top 4 vote-getters will be elected to the 2019-2020 MESF Board
- · Discussion regarding Executive board member voting:
  - President, Vice-President, and Treasurer positions are open
  - The following members have submitted their names for consideration:
    - 1. President- Heidi Perreault
    - 2. Vice President- Noelle Perrin and Melissa Meehan as Co-VPs
    - 3. Treasurer- Simona Achim-Verdugo

#### **Treasurer's Report: Jason Perrin**

- Review of 2019-2020 fiscal year budget
- · Notable changes in new budget:
  - two new spring events, no artwalk, no longer sponsoring 4th of July Event
- · Discussion about the 4th of July Event
  - Alice R spoke of history of event
  - From a financial perspective, Jason P reported that historically the 4th of July Event does not make much money and it is difficult to get volunteers
  - Melissa F volunteered to shadow Alice this year and to take over the position next year
- · Discussion regarding Classified Aids vs. Certificated aids
  - Mr. B explained the difference
  - Currently we have 3 Certificated and 9 Classified aids
  - Mrs. Smith gave her perspective on Mariners Teacher Aids
- Jason P reiterated that MESF funded an additional certificated teacher this year, resulting in a \$30k loss, salaries are up 5%, currently as it stands, the TA expense is unsustainable.
- Heidi P announced some changes in funding sources for 2019-2020:
  - Mr. Broesamle has offered to take on the copier budget of \$4k
  - PTA has agreed to fund Accelerated Programs and Science Education (\$19k)
- Discussion about Pledge Drive Donor Party for 2019-2020 school year donors
- 2019-2020 Fiscal Year Budget Vote:
  - Jason P Motioned to pass budget as presented in the budget packet with the following additions, \$2000 for community contributions revenue and \$1200 for donor party expense. Sean C 2nd the motion.
