President's Report: Heidi Perreault

- Welcome
- · As President, Heidi would like to start the meeting with an inspirational quote.

Treasurer's Report: Erica Williams

- Budget and pie charts are available at www.marinersfoundation.com
- For the 2019-2020 school year, #1 goal is to raise money needed for TAs (\$240k)
- \$350k is the "stretch" goal

- Projected expenses are \$325k, which is \$10k less than last year due to changes in line items (i.e. teacher grants, tech programs, etc.)
- Currently have \$170k in MESF accounts
- The 1st of 4 payments has been paid out to district for the Support Teachers/TA's (\$60k) and the last check for the copier was recently paid (\$1370)
- Mr. Broesamle will be taking over the copier payments for the 2019-2020 school year
- Recently switched MESF accounts from Union Bank to US Bank, currently have two credit cards, and a debit card
- Working on a financial model to be shared at MESF Board Meetings that will illustrate revenue/ fundraising goals vs. financial commitments and fundraising goal vs. currently standing based on each revenue stream
- To date, down \$10k to achieve minimum goal of \$240k

Principal's Report: Matt Broesamle

- · Thank you to the MESF Board
- Enrollment update, currently 650
- · Staff update, change from 29 to 27 teachers
- Ms. Polsgrove moved down to 2nd grade
- Actively looking to hire a tech aid and a new librarian
- MESF currently funds 3 hourly support teachers and 10 Teacher Assistants
- Starting a "Coffee with the principal" once a month to be held after flag deck. Will discuss the school's
 mission, professional development, and will also hold an open discussion and Q&A

Teacher's Report: none

- Heidi P welcomed teacher liaisons (Ms. Casler and Ms. Boyd)
- · She expressed appreciation for their time and voices
- Announcement that Shelley W is to be the room mom liaison

PTA Update: Charlene Foell

- PTA has financially taken over the following: science supplies, Accelerated Reader, and the Collin Kartchner assembly
- PTA/MESF bin was cleaned out at the end of last school year, however recently discovered that rats were still able to get in. Graduation banner got ruined.
- Heidi P worked with PTA to provided a "Year at a Glance" booklet with important dates for students and families
- Switching from Art Masters to a new art program (The Artist Lab)
- Increased the assembly budget for this year, more Science On The Go
- · Bringing back Reflections district wide art contest

Miscellaneous Business Report:

- · Joanna P reported on the Pledge Drive
 - Encouraged board to donate
 - Welcomed Nick P to pledge drive committee- Nick to track donations, send out thank you notes, and work on corporate matching
 - A special thank you to Chris Kraft for photography used in recent marketing materials and to Greg Wakeham for donating postcards that were distributed over the summer
 - This year, different theme and tagline which focuses on people we fund rather than material items
 - QR codes were utilized on all marketing materials
 - Accepting Venmo payments
 - This year's suggested donation is \$400 per student (compared to \$350/student last year)
 - The postcard went out a week later this year compared to last, overall numbers down

- Current stats compared to 2018-2019—
 - \$785 raised in August by 4 families this year vs. \$3950 Raised by 6 families in 2018-2019
 - First week of school this year, 13 families/\$5k vs. 24 families/\$11k in 2018-2019
 - 2018-2019 80 families donated in the month of September donating a total of \$35,780
