President's Report: Heidi Perreault

- Announcement that 11 current board families are stepping down in 2020-2021 leaving 12 open spots to fill the current 23 director positions
- Reminder that the MESF funds 9 Aids and 3 hourly support Teachers. English test scores have gone up double digits.

Treasurer's Report: Erica Williams

- · Provided copy of February and YTD Actual vs. Budget for the directors to review
- YTD total income up (over \$84k) and expenses are down (under \$20k), but will change with Spring Fundraiser coming up
- Current financials- \$60,498 in checking, \$204,384 in savings, \$100 is consistently maintained in Venmo, 3rd TA check was cashed
- Pledge Drive Red Envelope campaign brought in \$730 into Venmo account and \$605 cash/checks in envelopes
- Heidi P asked board to review budget and notify the board of any addendums to add to any current budget line items at the next meeting

Teacher's Report: Cara Boyd

- · Several kinder i-pads have operating systems that are starting to die and/or cannot perform updates
- Proposal for 37 new i-pads for 2020-2021 year which would allow 4th kinder class to provide 1:1 ipads and replace those in need (about 5 per classroom). Cost would be \$12,290 (\$309/i-pad) with an educator discount. She is also proposing to budget \$6500 per year for the following 2-3 years for future replacement.
- Jen Cox (Guest) informed board that her school leases the i-pads. She thinks they keep them for 3 years and then then get new ones with the leasing program. She volunteered to inquire about leasing program.

PTA Update: Noelle Perrin

- PTA has filled 2 openings, still need to fill President position
- New yearbook volunteer
- Jogathon is now April 17th- they are going to provide Marlin socks to all students
- PTA is researching cordless sound options (microphones) and putting together a proposal- NHHS does not provide sound equipment for the school play current microphones go in and out.

Miscellaneous Business Report:

- Nick P and Heather L reported on the Pledge drive
 - \$51k has been pledged in total (\$4600 left to collect by the end of year)
 - \$51k does not include the Venmo or recent red envelope donations
 - 6 Red Envelopes were turned in
 - In Venmo description, someone wrote "Teacher Aids" which is good sign that the marketing campaign focusing on what MESF funds is being conveyed to school community
- Shelley W reported on the Golf Tournament
 - Angie sent out an email regarding volunteer opportunities
 - Pamela W provided a list of potential silent auction donors and is asking for the board to review and sign up to help secure items
- Heidi P reported on the 4th of July event
 - Melissa F and Heidi proposed a beer garden to city, but it was denied
 - Currently have raised \$3k, need \$12k more in order to host event
