<u>Welcome</u> - President Heather Scheck called the meeting to order.

Special Presentation, Audio/Visual for PFT - Mark Ontiveros

- Mark Ontiveros is a parent at Mariners. He works for a company called Performance Media. He has extensive experience in taking bad acoustics and making it more livable.
- The PFT's main issue is acoustics. How to you solve the acoustical problem? Not by buying more sound equipment.
- Mr. Ontiveros and his colleague, Anthony Grimani did a thorough review of the current room and sound system. It is their opinion that the following should take place in order to improve the sound in the PFT:
 - Install absorber panels across 30% of the PFT, including the ceiling.
 - Install theatrical curtains where the existing vertical blinds are on the back wall.
 - Replace some of the current sound system, not all of it.
 - The total job could be completed for between \$12,000-\$15,000.
 - The Foundation will need to seek district/administrative approval before we can move forward on such a project.
