MINUTES

1. Welcome (Dianne Wells)

- Welcome Call to Order at 7:08 p.m.
- All NMUSD Foundation leaders received a brochure explaining the process the district will use in finding the new superintendent. Dr. Barbot will be the interim superintendent until June 26.
- The district is considering the community's opinion. Foundation leaders will also have an opportunity to meet with Dr. Barbot, if desired.
