# Principal Report - Mark Africano sitting in for Pam Coughlin

- Go easy on the kids during testing
- Passed out the "Newport-Mesa Unified School District Local Control and Accountability Plan 2015-2016 Goals. We are suppose to match their goals. The goals are the same for every elementary school. Our first goal is to reach 95% accuracy, same as last year for language arts. The second goal is 75% of students K-6 to meet benchmarks of Swun Math tests. The third goal is continue our pyramid of success goal by June so behavior issues decrease by 10%. (All of the reasoning and ways to get to our goal are in the packet.)

- Chrome Book Purchase: Final Purchase Plan (4 Classrooms):
