MINUTES

Meeting to Order (Mike Huntley)

- Welcome – Call to Order at 7:05 pm.
- April minutes have been approved and will be posted to the website.

Special Presentatoin – Chris Fogg from Discovery Science

- Chris Fogg and his family have been involved in science education for 25 years.
 - 25 years of after school & classroom enrichment
 - 15 years of science specialists where they run schools' labs providing kids hands on lab experience.
- They base their curriculum off the state standards.
- Their goal is to make each lesson hands on, and memorable. Examples of subjects include electricity (circuits & batteries), elements & the periodic table sound & vibrations (flute), air pressure (air helicopter), lenses (binoculars), light.

- For each grade level, they have 18-20 subjects. They work with the teachers to identify which subjects to teach, the corresponding experiment and the order in which to teach the subjects. Each subject is adjusted for the grade level.

Principal's Report (Jan Wood)

- State testing will occur the next 2 weeks. Make sure your children have a good night sleep, and a good breakfast. No visitors are allowed on campus during the testing period. The 5th graders will also be tested on science. The teachers have been preparing them since Kindergarten.
- The end of year is very busy. There will be a lot of activities between now and the end of the year.

Treasury Report (Meredith Cagle)

- Financials for February & March have been summarized and were circulated during the meeting.
- Also circulated and discussed was a summary of the 2009-2010 Budget, Projected Actuals for 2009-2010 and the Proposed Budget for 2010-2011.
 - April, May & June expenditures are projected rather than actual.
 - Art Walk and Independence Day figures are also projected.
 - This year we have a projected net gain of \$32,000. Therefore the 2010-2011 budget shows an proposed \$25,000 net loss to take advantage of the projected gain and to spend the money as close to period in which it was raised.
 - The proposed 2010-2011 budget shows a new science enrichment category and an increase to the technology budget.
- Meredith also distributed a pie chart of our budget by category. The chart clearly shows the majority of our budget is spent on personnel – 13 aides (4 fall under science) at \$10,000 each.
- Technology
 - Technology budget is almost double of that last year.
 - The PTA has also allocated extra money this year towards technology.
 - We would like to fill a Technology Liaison position.
- We will vote on the budget via email.

Spring Fundraiser/Art Walk (Nancy Terry)

- The Art Walk will take place on May 22nd at the ENC.
- On campus ticket sales will start on May 12th.
- Eva Palmer is coordinating the adult projects.
- The classroom art is trickling in. The classroom coordinator will have a choice of receiving \$100 reimbursement or being recognized as an In House Donor.

PTA Report (Meredith Cagle)

- The PTA was able to donate \$12,000 towards new computers.
- Working on their budget and will vote on it at the end of May.
- Book Fair was very successful.
- 5/14 will be Planetarium Night – free family fun with Original Pizza for \$1.00
